**ORDER EXTENDING METERING REQUIREMENT DEADLINE
FOR GROUNDWATER DIVERSIONS IN THE NAMBÉ
POJOAQUE TESUQUE WATER MASTER DISTRICT**


WHEREAS, on October 3, 2017, the State Engineer issued Order No. 186, requiring that all groundwater diversions in the Nambé Pojoaque Tesuque (“NPT”) Water Master District be equipped with a totalizing flow meter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Order, the deadline to equip all groundwater diversions within the NPT Water Master District was October 3, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Tom Blaine, State Engineer of the State of New Mexico, do hereby extend by one year the deadline to equip all groundwater diversions in the NPT with a functional totalizing flow meter to October 3, 2019. After October 3, 2019, no water shall be diverted from any groundwater diversion in the NPT Water Master District unless it is equipped with a functional totalizing flow meter.

MODIFICATION OF THIS ORDER: The State Engineer may, in his sole discretion, supplement or amend this Order as warranted, by issuance of further written orders modifying or superseding this Order.
