Application for Conservation Practices

The Reloan Program is a low-interest source of funding for water conservation projects, provided from the Irrigation Works Construction Fund and funded through the New Mexico Interstate Stream Commission (NMISC). The NMISC is authorized to make loans under this program pursuant to New Mexico Statutes 72-14-29 and 72-14-33 to irrigation and similar districts (Districts) organized under the laws of New Mexico, to municipalities and political subdivisions, and to acequias. Under this authority, the NMISC may make loans, wherein the Districts re-loan to individual or incorporated borrowers for the purpose stated in the statutes.
