(SANTA FE, New Mexico) – A public hearing regarding proposed regulations for a Strategic Water Reserve will be held by the Interstate Stream Commission on Thursday, October 20 2005, in Santa Fe.

The purpose of the proposed regulations is to assist the Interstate Stream Commission with the implementation of a Strategic Water Reserve.

In 2005, Governor Richardson signed into law Strategic Water Reserve legislation, which provides an additional tool to the state for meeting interstate stream compact deliveries and for managing water for the benefit of threatened and endangered species.
