(CLAYTON, New Mexico) – Office of the State Engineer staff will be available to answer questions regarding the new Clayton Underground Water Basin and the extensions to the Canadian River Underground Water Basins on Wednesday, October 26, 2005 in Clayton, New Mexico.

On September 23, 2005 the State Engineer signed six special orders declaring administration over six new underground water basins and extending the boundaries of nine existing underground water basins throughout the State of New Mexico.

The purpose of the declarations and extension of the basins is to provide for the statewide administration of underground water to accurately account for and administer the resources and to prevent impairment to valid existing rights.

A hearing on the declarations and extensions will be held at the Jerry Apodaca Education Building in Santa Fe on December 9, 2005.
