



# Media Advisory

(SANTA FE, New Mexico) – A public hearing to review comment and to hear testimony on the Proposed Domestic Well Rules and Regulations will be held on Friday, April 21, 2006, in Santa Fe.

The proposed regulations will govern diversion rates, domestic well management areas, expedited water right transfers, and domestic well fees in the state. They are intended to protect existing water rights, to assist in interstate compact compliance, and to formalize administrative practices for handling domestic wells.

The hearing culminates a three-month period of public review which included meetings held around the state to solicit public input on the proposed regulations.
