(ANGEL FIRE, New Mexico) – A settlement agreement will be signed in Angel Fire on **Friday, June 1, 2006**, ending 20 years of litigation and uncertainty relating to water in the Eagle Nest Reservoir.

Governor Richardson, Interstate Stream Commission Director Estevan Lopez, the Mayor of Angel Fire and others will be on hand to sign this agreement, which provides sufficient water in Eagle Nest Reservoir for fish and recreation.

The Governor's Office and the Interstate Stream Commission have assisted the Eagle Nest Water users in two years of negotiations to craft this settlement themselves, creating a shortage-sharing agreement reflective of the actual water supply.
