The Water Rights Division of the Office of the State Engineer will conduct a field office at the Sedan Volunteer Fire Department on June 29, 2006. The purpose of the field office is to have agency staff available on site to answer water rights questions in the Sedan area.

Forms will be available for registering (declaring) a water right and for documenting the change of ownership of a water right.

In addition, there will be a public meeting with opportunity for questions and answers and an informative presentation given by Office of the State Engineer staff.

The Office of the State Engineer is charged with administering the state's water resources. The State Engineer has power over the supervision, measurement, appropriation, and distribution of all surface and groundwater in New Mexico, including streams and rivers that cross state boundaries. The State Engineer is also Secretary of the Interstate Stream Commission and oversees its staff.
