## **Groundbreaking Ceremony for Seven Rivers Pipeline Project for the Pecos Settlement**

**(CARLSBAD, New Mexico)** – The Interstate Stream Commission will be breaking ground on the Seven Rivers Pipeline Project which is another milestone reached in the implementation of the Pecos River Settlement.

Interstate Stream Commission Director Estevan Lopez as well as representatives from US Senator Pete Domenici's office, US Bureau of Reclamation, Carlsbad Irrigation District, Pecos Valley Artesian Conservancy District and others will be breaking ground for the pipeline.

The pipeline stretches from the Seven Rivers area near Carlsbad to Brantley Lake on the Pecos River and is 12 inches to 36 inches wide. The pipeline has the capacity to deliver 20,000 acre-feet of water per year to the river.

The Seven Rivers Pipeline Project is expected to be completed by the end of 2007.
