**(LAS VEGAS, New Mexico)** – A forum called **Managing Water in the Rio Gallinas in 2008** will be held by the Office of the State Engineer/Interstate Stream Commission, New Mexico Department of Game and Fish, USDA Natural Resources Conservation Services, Tierra and Montes Soil and Water Conservation District, Rio de las Gallinas Acequias Association, and the City of Las Vegas. Managing Water in the Rio Gallinas in 2008 will be held on **Monday, March 31, 2008** in **Las Vegas, New Mexico**.

The intent of the forum is to provide an opportunity for everyone to learn of the water needs in the Rio Gallinas Basin, as well as the engineering and funding assistance available from federal and other governmental agencies related to water management.

Go up the hill .3 mile and turn left at the red building and go into the campus. Proceed and then turn right at the stop sign. Watch for signs with the Office of the State Engineer logo on them. The meeting will be held in the Samuel F Vigil Learning Resource Center Lecture Hall.
