“Duckolympics ” and Ribbon Cutting Celebrates Completion of Seven Rivers Pipeline Project for the Pecos Settlement

(CARLSBAD, New Mexico) – The Interstate Stream Commission will be celebrating the completion of the Seven Rivers Pipeline Project which is another milestone reached in the implementation of the Pecos River Settlement.

Interstate Stream Commission Director Estevan Lopez as well as representatives from US Bureau of Reclamation, Carlsbad Irrigation District, Pecos Valley Artesian Conservancy District and others will be participating in a ribbon cutting and ceremonial “duckolympics” to mark the occasion.

The pipeline stretches from the Seven Rivers area near Carlsbad to Brantley Lake on the Pecos River and is 12 inches to 36 inches wide. The pipeline has the capacity to deliver 20,000 acre-feet of water per year to the river.

The parties broke ground on the project one year ago on June 22, 2007.
