**NOTICE OF SECOND MEETING
TO DISCUSS PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER
AND NOTICE OF PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER**

The Navajo Nation, the United States of America, and the State of New Mexico *ex rel.* State Engineer, (collectively “Settling Parties”), provide notice of a second meeting to discuss a proposed scheduling order.

The Settling Parties and several other parties briefly met following the October 26, 2011, hearing regarding Objection to Entry of Appearance of Victor Marshall and Notice of Intent to Participate Filed by Victor Marshall and the Motion to Strike at the New Mexico Court of Appeals courtroom. Because the hearing ended around 4:30 p.m., little time remained to discuss the proposed scheduling order. In addition, the video link to the Aztec courtroom was turned off. Thus, the parties were unable to conduct a comprehensive meeting to discuss the proposed scheduling order. The parties in attendance agreed to meet again on November 2, 2011, from 8:30 to 10:00 a.m. in Room 295 (Building 2) of the Southwest Region Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs (1001 Indian School Road, NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87104). Due to the location of the meeting, no video link will be provided from any other location.
