Follow these easy steps to check your toilet for leaks:



1. Carefully remove the toilet tank lid.
2. Drop the dye tablet into the tank.
3. **DO NOT** flush the toilet.
4. Let the tablet dissolve, coloring the water in the tank.
5. After about 15 minutes, look in the toilet bowl for any colored water.
6. If there is any colored water in the bowl, your toilet is leaking.

Replace the old flapper!
