ORDER SETTING DEADLINES

THIS MATTER is before the Special Master pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 53, and the Order of Reference [Doc. No. 6336]. On October 24, 2014, a Status Conference was held at the United States Court House, 120 South Federal Place, Santa Fe, New Mexico. The Court set certain deadlines as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that to the extent Plaintiff the State of New Mexico will file a motion for an Order to Show Cause with respect to pre-basin wells, that motion shall be filed on or before **December 19, 2014**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **no later than January 30, 2015**, Plaintiff the State shall locate the remaining eight (8) subfile claimants it anticipates needing to serve by publication, or shall file a motion to serve those claimants by publication.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff the State and subfile claimant Addison Doty, Subfile PM-39822, shall file settlement documents with the Court on or before **October 31, 2014**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that to the extent Plaintiff the State of New Mexico will file a motion regarding trans-mountain water being diverted into the Rio Chupadero and/or the Rio en Medio, Plaintiff the State shall file its motion on or before **November 28, 2014**.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 20 DAYS OF SERVICE of a copy of this order, report, or recommendations, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 53(f)(2). A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the twenty-day period if that party wants the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the twenty-day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report or recommendations in whole.
