**STIPULATED AND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER
FOR FILING CORRECTIVE MOTIONS TO DESCRIBE THE RIGHT TO RECEIVE
WATER FROM THE RIO EN MEDIO FOR WATER RIGHTS IN THE RIO
CHUPADERO BASIN**

This matter comes before the Special Master on the request of Plaintiff State of New Mexico (the “State”) to amend the March 17, 2015, *Scheduling Order for Filing Corrective Motions to Describe the Right to Receive Water from the Rio en Medio for Water Rights in the Rio Chupadero Basin* (“Scheduling Order”) [Doc. 10132], pursuant to the State’s agreement with Las Acequias de Chupadero regarding the same. The parties, having conferred and held a telephonic conference with the Special Master, stipulate and agree to the following:

1. The Scheduling Order provides that on or before **April 17, 2015**, the State shall file motions to correct 40 subfiles to reference the right to receive water from the ditch diverting water from the Rio en Medio to the Rio Chupadero, as well as reference any points of diversion on the Rio Chupadero that may have been omitted, for water rights under these 40 subfiles.

2. The State has attempted to complete necessary fieldwork for the filing of corrective motions pursuant to the Scheduling Order. However, technical staff for the State has thus far been unable to complete this work due to snow and other conditions on the ground. The State believes that it may not be able to complete this work before the end of April 2015 due to the inaccessibility of certain locations including the point of diversion for the ditch that diverts water from the Rio en Medio to the Rio Chupadero for use by water rights owners in the Rio Chupadero Basin. For this reason, the State has requested an extension of the filing deadline in the Scheduling Order from April 17, 2015, to June 1, 2015.

3. Las Acequias de Chupadero does not oppose extension of the filing deadline to June 1, 2015.

WHEREFORE, the Special Master hereby amends the March 17, 2015, *Scheduling Order for Filing Corrective Motions to Describe the Right to Receive Water from the Rio en Medio for Water Rights in the Rio Chupadero Basin*, to extend the April 17, 2015, deadline for filing corrective motions to **June 1, 2015**.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 20 DAYS OF SERVICE of a copy of this order, report or recommendations, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 53(f)(2). A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the twenty-day period if that party wants

the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the twenty-day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report or recommendations in whole.
