OFFER OF JUDGMENT

COMES NOW the plaintiff and, subject to the approval of the Court, offers to suffer judgment against itself and in favor of the right of the defendant ~~J. B. NEWVILLE~~ *Edgar Pulliam* to withdraw public waters from the Nambe-Pojoaque River System as follows:

A. Purpose - Irrigation:

Amount of water: Not to exceed THREE 3.0 acre-feet per acre per annum delivered at the farm headgate.

B. Purpose - Domestic and/or Stock (underground water):

PROVIDED, however, that acceptance by the defendants shall confer upon the plaintiff authority to demand judgment against the defendant, EDGAR PULLIAM in respect to all other public water use for irrigation from the Nambu-Pojoaque River System, on lands served by the ACEQUIA BARRANCO Ditch. These lands are described in the State Engineer's Hydrographic survey of the Nambu-Pojoaque River System.
