ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR DISCOVERY,
SUBFILES PM-30627 AND PM-89217

THIS MATTER is before the Special Master, entered pursuant to the Order of Reference [Doc. No. 6336], the Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Under Domestic Wells Permitted After January 13, 1983 [Doc. No. 6239], the Notice and Order to Show Cause [Doc. No. 7861], Fed.R.Civ.P. 53, and upon the July 2, 2015 telephonic conference with counsel for Plaintiff the State and Defendant Christian Gossein regarding extensions of the deadlines contained in the April 13, 2015 Scheduling Order Adopting, in Part, Joint Status Report and Provisional Discovery Plan, Subfiles PM-30627 and PM-89217, Consolidated (No. 10168).

Being otherwise fully advised in the premises, and finding good cause shown, the Special Master hereby **ORDERS** that the Scheduling Order is amended, and the deadlines for subfiles PM-30627 and PM-89217 are extended, only as follows:

The termination date for discovery shall be **September 30, 2015**;

Motions relating to discovery (including, but not limited to, motions to compel and motions for protective order) shall be filed with the Court and served on opposing parties by **October 3, 2015**;

Unless previously disclosed, Plaintiff shall identify to the parties hereto in writing any expert witness to be used by Plaintiff at trial and shall provide expert reports pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(2)(B) no later than **August 14, 2015**;

All other parties shall identify in writing any expert witness to be used by such parties at trial and shall provide expert reports pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(2)(B) no later than **August 14, 2015**;

Rebuttal reports from retained experts pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(2) shall be due from both Plaintiff and Defendants no later than **August 31, 2015**;

Pretrial motions, other than discovery motions, shall be filed with the Court and served on opposing parties by **September 30, 2015**;

All other deadlines are stayed pending a status conference, to be held on a date to be later determined.

THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 20 DAYS OF SERVICE of a copy of this order, report, or recommendation, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil procedure 53(f)(2). A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the twenty-day period if that party wants the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the twenty-day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report of recommendations in whole.
