**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT SUBFILE ORDER  
TO ADD OMITTED GROUNDWATER POINT OF DIVERSION  
FOR DOMESTIC/LIVESTOCK WELL (SUBFILE NO. 29.9)**

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the *Motion to Correct Subfile Order to Add Omitted Groundwater Point of Diversion for Domestic/Livestock Well (Subfile No. 29.9)* (Doc. 10230, July 10, 2015) filed by the State of New Mexico (the “State”).

No responses opposing the motion have been filed. Having reviewed the Motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Court will grant the motion.

IT IS ORDERED, THEREFORE, Subsection B of Paragraph 5 of the March 14, 1969, Subfile Order entered in Subfile No. 29.9 is corrected to describe the well location/point of diversion for the two groundwater right adjudicated for domestic or livestock use (RG-5256 and RG-64427) as follows:

1. Purpose: Domestic use for One Household pursuant to NMSA § 72-12-1 and -1.1

State Engineer File No.: RG-5256

Priority: October 13, 1960

Point of Diversion: X= 599,188 Y= 1,726,064 on the New Mexico State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, 1927 N.A.D.

Place of Use: Within the property owned by the Defendant(s) served by the well

Amount of Water: Not to exceed a diversion of 3.0 acre-feet per year from the well described above or the historic beneficial use, whichever is less.

2. Purpose: Non NMSA § 72-12-1 and -1.1 Domestic use for One Household and/or Livestock (Groundwater Only)

State Engineer File No.: RG-64427

Priority: July, 1956

Point of Diversion: X= 599,251 Y= 1,726,250 on the New Mexico State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, 1927 N.A.D.

Place of Use: Within the property owned by the Defendant(s) served by the well

Except as expressly corrected by this Order, all other elements of the rights adjudicated under Subfile No. 29.9 remain as stated in the March 14, 1969, Subfile Order and subsequent orders of the Court.
