

ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Pawel Fludzinski and Janet Fludzinski's Unopposed Motion to Substitute Parties, Doc. 10960, filed October 31, 2016. The Fludzinskis are the successors in ownership to the groundwater right under Office of the State Engineer Permit No. RG-70046 and seek to be substituted as defendants for the previous owner, Robert Thommen II, in this matter pursuant to Rule 25(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Rule 25(c) states: "If an interest is transferred, the action may be continued by or against the original party unless the court, on motion, orders the transferee to be substituted in the action or joined with the original party." No responses opposing the motion have been filed. The Court will **GRANT** the Motion.
