For Subfile RG-56923, no party or attorney appeared. The Special Master has issued an Order to Show Cause. This Scheduling Order applies to this Subfile pending further Order of the Special Master or the Court.

After discussion and consent of the parties, the following deadlines were set with respect to the adjudication of these subfiles:

1. The parties shall meet-and-confer with respect to discovery issues on or before **January 6, 2017**.
2. The parties' initial disclosures pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26 and Local Rule D.N.M.-LR Civ. 26.3 shall be due on or before **January 13, 2016**.
3. Any discovery requests (interrogatories, requests for production, requests for inspection, requests for admission) shall be transmitted to the opposing party on or before **February 3, 2017**.
4. Responses to discovery requests shall be due on or before **February 17, 2017**.
5. Parties seeking depositions shall arrange a telephonic conference call with the Special Master.
6. Dispositive motions shall be filed on or before **March 3, 2017**.
7. Responses to dispositive motions shall be filed on or before **March 17, 2017**.
8. No replies to dispositive motions shall be allowed absent further order from the Special Master or the Court.

9. Trial of any matters with respect to these subfiles shall take place on April 7, 2017. The Special Master will hold a pre-trial conference at a date and time to be announced.

THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 14 DAYS OF SERVICE [Doc. No. 10791] of a copy of this order, report, or recommendation, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil procedure 53(f)(2). A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the fourteen day period if that party wants the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the fourteen day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report of recommendations in whole.
