ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the State of New Mexico's Motion for Default Judgment, Doc. 10261, filed August 10, 2015.

The State of New Mexico's Motion states that Defendant Linda M. Salazar is in default for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend regarding Subfile AAM-RG-28695, and requests the Court to enter its order granting default judgment incorporating the terms of the State's proposed consent order in Subfile AAM-RG-28695. The State subsequently submitted a consent order for Subfile AAM-RG-28695, accepted and signed by Linda M. Salazar, to the Special Master, which was entered by the Court on September 17, 2015. *See* Doc. 10349. The Court will, therefore, deny the State's Motion for Default Judgment as moot.

IT IS ORDERED that the State of New Mexico's Motion for Default Judgment, Doc. 10261, filed August 10, 2015, is **DENIED as moot**.
