This application is approved provided it is not exercised to the detriment of any others having prior valid and existing rights to the use of said surface and underground water sources or to the detriment of any rights acquired prior to this application; further provided that all rules and regulations of the State Engineer pertaining to the drilling of wells be complied with Well shall be drilled by a drilling contractor licensed by the State Engineer of New Mexico. Appropriation of water from all sources combined to be limited at all times to a maximum of 3 acre feet per acre per annum. Water from well is to be supplemental to surface water rights at all times.

This form shall be executed, preferably typewritten, in triplicate and must be accompanied by a \$5.00 filing fee. Each triplicate copy must be properly signed and attested. If applicant is not recorded owner of water right, Change of Ownership affidavit must accompany this application. If additional space is required use a separate sheet or sheets and attach securely hereto.

Note: It is unlawful, after a transfer has been completed, to apply water on the lands or uses from which right has been severed, or to use more water than the owner had a valid right to use before change was made. Supplementary water rights, by their very nature, cease to exist for those lands from which rights are transferred; also they cannot be transferred to other lands as new or primary water rights.

All blanks in Sections 1--7 shall be filled out fully and accurately. Secs. 2--3 Describe all essential features of the water right or rights involved in the proposed change. Sec. 4 Explain fully why change is desired or necessary. Sec. 5 Describe well (or wells) to which change is to be made and, if an existing well, set forth any other rights appurtenant thereto. Sec. 6 Explain any features or conditions not made clear in previous sections. Sec. 8 This section, to be filled out by the State Engineer, gives his approval or disapproval of the application, the conditions under which approval is granted and sets the limiting date for completing such changes.

Important: The location of the point of diversion to be changed from, the well (or wells) to be changed to, and the acreage to be supplied from the latter must be shown as accurately as possible on the above plat.
