**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT SUBFILE ORDER TO ADOPT
PRIORITY DATE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL GROUNDWATER
IRRIGATION WATER RIGHT (SUBFILE NOS. 16.2 & 16.7)**

The Court, having considered the *Motion to Correct Subfile Order to Adopt Priority Date for Supplemental Groundwater Irrigation Water Right (Subfile Nos. 16.2 & 16.7)* (Doc. _____, March _____) filed by the State of New Mexico (the “State”), and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, finds that the State’s Motion is well-taken, and that it should be GRANTED.

IT IS ORDERED, THEREFORE, that a December 31, 1953 priority is adopted for the supplemental groundwater irrigation water rights adjudicated under Subfile Nos. 16.2 and 16.7

for diversion from Well No. RG-3929. "Point of Diversion" in subpart A of Paragraph 5 of the May 8, 1968 Order entered in Subfile Nos. 16.2 and 16.7 is hereby corrected to state the following:

Groundwater:	Well No. RG-3929 located in the SW ¼ SE ¼ NE ¼ Sec. 6, T. 18N, R. 10E
Priority:	12/31/1953

Except as expressly corrected by this Order, all other elements of the rights adjudicated under Subfile Nos. 16.2 and 16.7 should remain as stated in the May 8, 1968 Order and subsequent orders of the Court.
