**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT SUBFILE ORDER TO ADOPT  
PRIORITY DATE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL GROUNDWATER  
IRRIGATION WATER RIGHT (SUBFILE NO. 27.20)**

The Court, having considered the *Motion to Correct Subfile Order to Adopt Priority Date for Supplemental Groundwater Irrigation Water Right (Subfile No. 27.20)* (Doc. \_\_\_\_\_, March \_\_\_\_\_) filed by the State of New Mexico (the “State”), and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, finds that the State’s Motion is well-taken, and that it should be GRANTED.

IT IS ORDERED, THEREFORE, that a December 31, 1945 priority is adopted for the supplemental groundwater irrigation water right adjudicated for diversion from Well No. RG-52535. “Point of Diversion” in subpart A of Paragraph 5 of the May 8, 1968 Order entered in Subfile No. 27.20 is hereby corrected to state the following:

Groundwater: Well No. RG-52535 located in the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$   
Sec. 25, T. 18N, R. 9E  
Priority: 12/31/1945

Except as expressly corrected by this Order, all other elements of the rights adjudicated under Subfile No. 27.20 should remain as stated in the May 8, 1968 Order and subsequent orders of the Court.
