**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT
SURFACE WATER POINT OF DIVERSION FOR SUBFILES
SERVED BY TESUQUE INDIAN PUEBLO DITCH NO. 7 [Doc. No. 10478]**


THIS MATTER is before the Court on the State of New Mexico's *Motion to Correct Surface Water Point of Diversion for Subfiles Served by Tesuque Indian Pueblo Ditch No. 7*, filed January 25, 2016 [Doc. No. 10478] pursuant to the Court's July 23, 2013, *Procedural Order for Correcting Subfile Errors* [Doc. No. 7909]. No responses were filed to the motion.

Subfile orders adjudicating surface water irrigation rights served by the Tesuque Indian Pueblo Ditch No. 7 were entered in the following subfiles: 27.69, 27.69-A, 27.69-B, 27.69-C, 27.70. As set forth in the State's Motion, the subfile orders contain an error in the legal description of the ditch's point of diversion on the Rio Tesuque. The State therefore requests an

order correcting the legal description in the subfile orders. Having been fully advised in the premises, the Court finds the Motion well taken.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that each subfile order adjudicating a surface water irrigation right under the Tesuque Indian Pueblo Ditch No. 7 is corrected to describe the ditch's surface water point of diversion as follows:

The Tesuque Indian Pueblo Ditch No. 7 (also known as the Mitchell or Spring Ditch) diverts water from the Rio Tesuque in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25, T. 18 N., R. 9. E., at a point located at X: 592,791 and Y: 1,735,129, NM State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, NAD 1927.
