7. Additional statements or explanations In order that the appropriation under this application to change point of diversion, from a point in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4, of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 9 East, on Tesuque Creek, to a well to be located as described above, will not impair existing rights, the applicant is willing to discontinue use of surface water for the irrigation of 66.71 acres of land described in Sub-files 19.1 thru 19.24 of United States District Court Cause No. 6639 Civil and shown on Nambe-Pojoaque Hydrographic Survey Sheet 19. By discontinuing the use of surface waters with a priority prior to 1907, the exact date to be determined in United States District Court Cause No. 6639 Civil, the annual diversion of 3 acre feet per acre per annum from such irrigation, and its priority, is to be transferred to the well. Applicant seeks permit to change point of diversion from surface to underground water for the purpose of eliminating the cost of concrete lining and maintaining the ditch from the point of diversion on Tesuque Creek to the first use. The source of water has been a diversion dam on the creek and a pipe imbedded in the river sands to supplement the surface flows. The use of the pipe was first made in the early 1920's when a clay pipe was installed. This was replaced by 1800 feet of perforated galvanized pipe in 1947. Applicant claims the right to divert the total of 200.13 acre feet of water per annum from the well, as a full historical supply has been realized through the use of the diversion dam and underground pipes in the river bed.

I, J. R. Raybal, affirm that the foregoing statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief and that development shall not commence until approval of the permit has been obtained.

ACTION OF STATE ENGINEER

After notice pursuant to statute and by authority vested in me, this application is approved provided it is not exercised to the detriment of any others having existing rights; further provided that all rules and regulations of the State Engineer pertaining to the drilling of shallow wells be complied with; and further subject to the following conditions:

Appropriation of water from all sources combined shall be limited at all times to a maximum of 3 acre feet per acre per annum, measured at the well.
This application is approved subject to the decrees of the court under U. S. District Court Cause No. 6639.

INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be executed, preferably typewritten, in triplicate and shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$5.00.

Each of triplicate copies must be properly signed and attested.

A separate application for permit must be filed for each well used.

Secs. 1-4—Fill out all blanks fully and accurately.

Sec. 5—Irrigation use shall be stated in acre feet of water per acre per annum to be applied on the land. If for municipal or other purposes, state total quantity in acre feet to be used annually.

Sec. 6—Describe only the lands to be irrigated or where water will be used. If on unsurveyed lands describe by legal subdivision "as projected" from the nearest government survey corners, or describe by metes and bounds and tie survey to some permanent, easily located natural object.

Sec. 7—If lands are irrigated from any other source, explain in this section. Give any other data necessary to fully describe water right sought.
