**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE ORDER GRANTING DEFAULT JUDGMENT  
ADJUDICATING POST-1982 DOMESTIC WELL SUBFILE RG-78856 FOR  
STEPHANIE D. KELLY AND ENTER REVISED SIGNED CONSENT ORDER**

The State of New Mexico ex rel. State Engineer (“State”) hereby moves the Court to pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b) vacate its March 12, 2014 *Order Granting Default Judgment* (No. 8207), and enter the Consent Order adjudicating the Post-1982 domestic well water right associated with subfile RG-78856, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and in support thereof, states as follows:

1. On November 6, 2013, the State filed its *Motion for Default Judgment* (No. 8001) regarding post-1982 domestic well water rights under subfile RG-78856 for Defendant Stephanie D. Kelly.

2. The State's *Motion* correctly stated that the Defendant was in default for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend in this cause, and referenced the November 5, 2013 *Clerk's Certificate of Default* (No. 8000) showing the same.

3. On March 12, 2014, the Court entered the *Order Granting Default Judgment* (No. 8207), adjudicating the post-1982 domestic well water rights under subfile RG-78856.

4. Subsequent to the entry of the *Order*, Defendant Stephanie D. Kelly, now Stephanie D. Madrid, contacted the State, and alerted it to the fact that her well was a multiple household use well, not a single household use well, as the *Order* reflected.

5. The State undertook an investigation of Defendant's assertion, and found it to be correct.

6. Defendant Stephanie D. Madrid and the State have both signed a Consent Order adjudicating the post-1982 water right under subfile RG-78856 consistent with the above described investigation, and the actual quantity of water beneficially used from the well. The Consent Order is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

7. Contemporaneously with the filing of this Motion, the State will submit the Consent Order to the Special Master.

8. Defendant Stephanie D. Madrid does not oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, the State requests that the Court vacate its March 12, 2014 *Order Granting Default Judgment* (No. 8207), and enter the Consent Order adjudicating the post-1982 domestic well water right associated with subfile RG-78856 attached hereto as Exhibit A.
