

Special Master's Order of Reference to hear and determine all claims and contentions relating to the elements of a state-law based domestic use rights to the underground waters of the stream system encompassed by this case and any errors or omissions process which may follow [Doc. 6336], the Special Master finds the Motion to Substitute should be granted and that the *inter se* objection should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that Defendant Jessica A. Trujillo's *Inter Se* Objection filed January 25, 2017 [Doc. No. 11303] be, and hereby is, **dismissed with prejudice**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Jessica A. Trujillo's motion for substitution of parties filed March 24, 2017 [Doc. No. 11436] be, and hereby is, **granted**, and that Jessica A. Trujillo be, and hereby is, substituted as the owner of record for Subfile PM-41219.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jessica A. Trujillo shall obtain without delay the current address of Curtis Novak and shall mail a copy of this order, first class postage prepaid, to Curtis Novak at that address.

THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 14 DAYS OF SERVICE [Doc. No. 10791] of a copy of this order, report, or recommendation, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil procedure 53(f)(2). A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the fourteen day period if that party wants the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the fourteen day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report of recommendations in whole.
