NOTICE is hereby given that on August 5, 2019, applicant Toby Cordova & Mary Ann Cordova, Trustees for the Cordova Living Trust, 1100 Parkview Dr., Los Lunas, NM 87031, filed Application No. SD-09361 with the STATE ENGINEER for Permit to Change Place of Use of Surface Water within the Rio Grande Stream System of the State of New Mexico.

Valencia County is the County affected by the diversion and in which the water has been or will be put to beneficial use. This notice is ordered to be published in the *Valencia County News-Bulletin*.

The applicant proposes to discontinue the farm delivery requirement of 14.4483 acre-feet of surface water per annum (AFA) from the La Constancia Ditch, with a point of diversion on the Rio Grande at the Isleta Diversion Dam located at a point where X=346,037 meters, Y=3,863,880 meters, UTM Zone 13N, NAD83, on land owned by the Pueblo of Isleta, for the irrigation of 4.8161 acres of land owned by the applicant, described as Part of Tracts A-3-B, A-3-C, A-4-A and A-4-B, Land Division Tracts A-2, A-3, and A-4, Lands of Trinidad Romero, MRGCD Map 85, Valencia County, New Mexico. The above-described, move-from tracts are located east of the Rio Grande, approximately 0.6 mile east of the intersection of NM Highway 47 and Romero Rd. in Los Lunas, Valencia County, New Mexico.

The applicant further proposes to commence the diversion of the above-described water rights from the New Belen Acequia, with a point of diversion on the Rio Grande at the Isleta Diversion Dam located at a point described above, for the irrigation of 4.8161 acres of land owned by the applicant, described as the East Part of Tract C1A, Replat of Land of Marcel C. Reynolds and Connie M. Reynolds, comprising Tracts C1, E, and E-1 Chamisa Farms, MRGCD Map 90, Valencia County, New Mexico. The above-described, move-to tract is located west of the Rio Grande, approximately 0.2 mile north of the intersection of John Rd. and Edmundo Rd. in Los Chaves, Valencia County, New Mexico.

Any person, firm, or corporation or other entity having standing to file objections or protests shall do so in writing (objection must be legible, signed, and include the writer's complete name, phone number, email address, and mailing address). The objection to the approval of the application must be based on: (1) Detriment; if detriment, you must specifically identify your water rights; and/or (2) Public Welfare/Conservation of Water; if public welfare or conservation of water within the state of New Mexico, you must show how you will be substantially and specifically affected. The written protest must be filed, in triplicate, with the State Engineer, 5550 San Antonio Drive NE, Albuquerque, NM 87109-4127, on or before October 25, 2019. Facsimiles (faxes) will be accepted as a valid protest as long as the hard copy is hand-delivered or mailed and postmarked within 24-hours of the facsimile. Mailing postmark will be used to validate the 24-hour period. Protests can be faxed to the Office of the State Engineer, (505) 383-

4030. If no valid protest or objection is filed, the State Engineer will evaluate the application in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 72 NMSA 1978.
