NOTICE is hereby given that on August 22, 2019, co-applicants, Anthony and Kristen Graham Chavez, 613 Perfecto Lopez Rd., Corrales, NM 87048, and Marty J. and Teresa L. Wright, P.O. Box 263, Veguita, NM 87062, filed Application No. SD-09840 with the **STATE ENGINEER** for permit to Change Place of Use and Point of Diversion from Surface Water to Groundwater in the Middle Rio Grande Water Basin of the State of New Mexico.

Valencia, Bernalillo, and Sandoval are the Counties affected by the diversion and in which the water has been or will be put to beneficial use. This notice is ordered to be published in the Valencia County News-Bulletin and the Albuquerque Journal.

The applicants propose to discontinue the Farm Delivery Requirement (FDR) of 2.2557 acre-feet per annum (afa) of surface water, inclusive of a Consumptive Irrigation Requirement (CIR) of 1.5789 afa from the Tome Acequia, with a point of diversion on the Rio Grande at the Isleta Diversion Works of the MRGCD, located on land owned by Isleta Pueblo and leased to MRGCD, at a point where X=346,037 and Y=3,863,880, meters, UTM Zone 13N, NAD83 in the NE1/4 NE/14 SW1/4, Section 24, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, NMPM, Valencia County, for the irrigation of 0.7519 acres of land owned by Marty J. and Teresa L. Wright, described as Tract 59D1A of the Plat Showing Split of Tr. 59D1 on MRGCD Map 85, within Section 16, Township 6 North, Range 2 East, NMPM. The move-from lands are located on Don Luis Rd. one quarter mile north of the intersection of Don Luis Rd. and Silva Rd. and 0.6 miles west of Tome, Valencia County.

The applicants further propose to transfer said surface water right of 1.5789 afa (CIR) to well RG-84743 located within the Alameda Grant at a point where X=352,674 and Y=3,900,822, meters UTM Zone 13, NAD83, for drip irrigation purposes on 1.2645 acres of land owned by Anthony and Kristen Graham Chavez, described as Final Plat, Lots "A-1-A" and "A-1-B" Lands of Aguilar Freeman & Marquez (Being a replat of Lot "A-1", Lands of Aguilar, Freeman & Marquez) and Tr. 3D/4E/A of a Plat of Deeded Properties (being a replat of Tr 3D/4E), within Section 27 of Township 12 North, Range 3 East, NMPM. The move-to lands and well RG-84743 are located on Perfecto Lopez Rd., approximately 0.33 miles northwest of the intersection of Loma Larga Rd. and Perfecto Lopez Rd. in the Village of Corrales, Sandoval County.

Any person, firm or corporation or other entity having standing to file objections or protests shall do so in writing (objection must be legible, signed, and include the writer's complete name, phone number, email address, and mailing address). The objection to the approval of the application must be based on: (1) Impairment; if impairment, you must specifically identify your water rights; and/or (2) Public Welfare/Conservation of Water; if public welfare or conservation of water within the state of New Mexico, you must show how you will be substantially and specifically affected. The written protest must be filed, in triplicate, with the Office of the State Engineer, 5550 San Antonio Dr. NE, Albuquerque, NM, 87109, on or before November 22, 2019. Facsimiles (faxes) will be

accepted as a valid protest if the hard copy is hand-delivered or mailed and postmarked within 24-hours of the facsimile. Mailing postmark will be used to validate the 24-hour period. Protests can be faxed to the Office of the State Engineer, 505-383-4030. If no valid protest or objection is filed, the State Engineer will evaluate the application in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 72 NMSA 1978.
